Bayside Station LIRR Freight Building Update

Renovations will begin soon on the LIRR freight building, the new home of the Bayside Business Association. We are hoping the renovation will not take too long so that we can get the building up and running to serve the local business area.

Street Renovation

We have just received approval from the DOT for the plans we submitted for the Bell Blvd renovation. Through the generosity of Senator Frank Padavan, we were able to complete construction drawings with all approvals for the portion of Bell Blvd. from Northern Blvd to 35th Ave. As funds become available, we hope to continue the streetscape on Bell Blvd, south of Northern Blvd to 48th Ave. Construction on the block of the LIRR overpass is scheduled to begin shortly.
